MEMORANDUM

The Finance Department in response to our proposal had concurred to the quarterly payment of subsidy towards electricity and the deposit of Electricity Duty collected by a DISCOM at the end of every quarter instead of the hitherto annual settlement process by their U.O. No. 2533 (Group-N) dated November 9, 2020. The electricity duty so collected from the consumers actually should be submitted in the prescribed ED Return which can be generated and sent electronically.

2. It is, hence, requested that claims for settlement of subsidy be submitted at the end of each quarter to the Power Department after the deposit of electricity duty collected for the previous quarter.

3. It is also further clarified that the Finance Department has permitted the drawal of bills in anticipation of allotment by its Memorandum No. 1422-F(Y) dated March 26, 2020 at Para No. 4 (XVII). Hence, there is no reason for offices of various Government Departments not to pay the bills in time before the late payment surcharge kicks in.
